## BYLAW 15/06

### A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE


The council of the Resort Village of Metinota, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Council shall provide fire protective services to deal with fires.
2. The Resort Village of Metinota shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment of fire protective service.
3. The Council may co-operate with Councils of other municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operation of fire protective service.
4. In the case where fire fighting service is required, the owner of the property where the service is provided is responsible for the cost incurred. These changes will become effective as of March 1, 2007.
